Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as Unit 2 was stopped at a steady red light in the eastbound lane of SR30 (Lincoln Way E) just west of its intersection with SR233 (Rocky Mtn. Rd.), Greene Township, Franklin County. Unit 1 was traveling east on SR30 and approaching Unit 2. Operator 1 failed to observe Unit 2 stopped in the roadway and as a result, the front of Unit 1 struck the rear of Unit 2 causing disabling damage to Unit 1. Unit 2

sustained minor damage and was able to be driven from the scene. Operator 1 was not wearing a safety belt and sustained minor injuries. Operator 1 transported by Fayetteville Volunteer Fire Department and subsequently flown to York Hospital for treatment. Unit 1 was towed from the scene by Rifes Towing.
