Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred on I-80 E, mm 88.3, Washington Township, Jefferson County. Unit #1 was traveling east in the left when for unknown reasons traveled off the left side of the roadway striking small trees and then striking an embankment coming to final rest against the embankment.

The Operator of Unit #1 was flown to UPMC Altoona by STAT MedEvac due to injuries suffered.

PennDOT was notified of one lane being shut down.

Jefferson County EMA Director Tracy ZENTS was on scene and Jefferson County Hazmat crew due to small fuel leak.
