PennDOT Reminds Drivers Left Turns onto Route 119 Prohibited

Clearfield, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) reminded drivers in Sandy Township, Clearfield County, today that **left turns** from Route 4012 (Liberty Road) onto Route 119 are prohibited.

In 2021, constituents concerned that sight distance at the intersection is insufficient to allow for the safe completion of a left turn onto Route 119 contacted PennDOT and the Sandy Township Board of Supervisors. These discussions prompted PennDOT to conduct a traffic study that determined the concerns were legitimate and the change justified under federal and state regulations.

PennDOT posted new signage at the intersection in December that is legally enforceable by police. Sandy Township Police will be monitoring the intersection and conducting enforcement details to further educate motorists. PennDOT urges drivers to obey posted signage and always buckle up to avoid receiving a citation or becoming involved in a crash.

Motorists are encouraged to "Know Before They Go" by checking conditions on more than 40,000 roadway miles by visiting www.511PA.com. 511PA, which is free and available 24 hours a day, provides traffic delay warnings, weather forecasts, traffic speed information and access to more than 1,000 traffic cameras.

511PA is also available through a smartphone application for iPhone and Android devices, by calling 5-1-1, or by following regional Twitter alerts accessible on the 511PA website.

PSP DuBois is investigating a crash which occurred at the above location during the above date and time. Operator #1 lost control of Unit #1 due to icy and snow-covered roadway. Unit #1 spun off the roadway in a clockwise direction. Unit #1 continued off the roadway in an east bound direction into a ditch and rolled onto the drive side of the vehicle then the roof coming to an uncontrolled final rest. Both the Operator and Passenger were taken from the scene by the ambulance to Penn Highlands DuBois for Medical Treatment.

Crash Synopsis:

This one vehicle crash occurred at the 87.3 westbound mile marker on Interstate 80, Pine Creek Twp., Jefferson County. Unit 1 was traveling westbound in the right travel lane when sudden snowfall causing a white-out effect began. Operator 1 lost control of Unit 1 and struck the guiderail off the right shoulder. Unit 1 did a 360 degree spin before coming to a final rest, facing west, partially in the right travel lane. Operator 1 was able to move Unit 1 approximately 50 feet up the roadway to get onto the shoulder.

No injuries were reported as a result of this crash.
