Crash Synopsis:

LOCATION:
This crash occurred on 10/29/23 at approximately 2230 hours, and occurred on the off-ramp from SR309 south to Bethlehem Pike, West Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

SYNOPSIS:
This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling south on the SR309 south off-ramp to Bethlehem Pike. Unit 1 exited the roadway in a southern direction, traveling up a hill and striking a tree. Unit 1 continued to strike additional trees and eventually overturning onto the passenger side. During the course of Unit 1's uncontrolled travel, Operator 1 was ejected through the windshield. Unit 1 came to an uncontrolled final rest on the passenger side and became involved in fire. Operator 1 was located outside the vehicle with a an open wound to his upper body. Unit 1 was transported to Grand View Hospital with serious injuries. Statements from Police and EMS on scene indicate the odor of an alcoholic beverage was present on Operator 1's person, and he admitted to smoking marijuana which he believed to "laced".
