Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred on Red Bridge Road (T438) at its intersection with Durham Road (SR212), Durham Township, Bucks County. Unit 1 was traveling southbound on Durham Road when Operator 1 attempted to turn north onto Red Bridge Road. Operator 1 was traveling at a high rate of speed and exited the wet roadway onto the western roadside. Unit 1 hit a traffic sign at its twelve o'clock position, destroying the sign, before rolling an unknown number of times. Unit 1 continued northerly hitting Unit 2 at its nine o'clock position causing heavy damage. Unit 1 came to an uncontrolled final rest on the western roadside of Red Bridge Road on its roof. Unit 2 was unoccupied at the time of the crash. Operator 1, the sole occupant of Unit 1, was wearing a seatbelt at the time of the crash. Front and side airbags of Unit 1 deployed. Operator 1 was able to exit the vehicle unassisted and reported

Crash Synopsis:**Scene Location:**

On 11/14/23 at approximately 0639 hours, a one-vehicle reportable collision occurred on River Road near Bridge Street in Tinicum Township, Bucks County. It was daytime at the time of this collision. River Road in the area of this crash was a posted 40 mile per hour zone. The roadway on River Road is straight in the area of the crash with one (1) lanes of travel going North and one (1) going South. River Road is adjacent to the Delaware River.

Crash Description:

This collision occurred as Unit 1 was traveling South on River Road. Operator # 1 stated a deer ran in front of his vehicle and he swerved to the left and hit the deer. Unit # 1 hit the deer with it right front corner. Unit # 1 continued left of the roadway into a grassy shoulder and then into shrubs and an embankment. Unit # 1 continued down the embankment and flipped upside down. Unit # 1 came to final rest in the Delaware river
