INCIDENT DETAILS:

On 12/21/2022 at 2355 hours PSP Gettysburg observed a red Ford Explorer traveling west on York St inside Gettysburg Borough without any headlights on. The vehicle then went the wrong way around the traffic circle located inside Gettysburg Borough. PSP Gettysburg attempted to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle which failed to stop when the emergency lights and sirens were activated. The vehicle began driving the the wrong way on Baltimore Street and proceeded thorough several red traffic signals.

A pursuit was initiated and traffic considerations were low / non-existent. The vehicle continued to swerve wildly across the roadway and fluctuated speed. A pursuit lasted approximately 3 miles when the vehicle struck a Met-Ed utility pole.

The operator of the vehicle was a 10 year old juvenile male with his 6 year old brother as a passenger.

Both juveniles were uninjured and returned home to their mother.

INCIDENT DETAILS:

On the above date and time a traffic stop was attempted on a vehicle traveling 99 MPH in a posted 65 MPH zone. The vehicle was an airport Taxi from Richmond Virginia. The vehicle fled northbound on US15 at a high rate of speed and passed vehicles on the right shoulder at speeds in excess of 120 MPH. Troopers Jared DOUNOUK and Heather MUELLER joined the pursuit as it continued northbound. After a 16 mile pursuit, the vehicle abruptly pulled to the shoulder and the driver was taken into custody. It was found that the driver had stolen the Taxi in Richmond Virginia earlier in the day. He was transported to Adams County Prison where he was arraigned.
