## Crash Synopsis:

This collision occurred as Unit #1 was traveling west on 10078 approaching mile marker 9.8 in the right lane. Operator #1 lost control of the vehicle and spun to the left onto the left shoulder of 10078 west at mile maker 9.8. The right side rear quarter panel collided with the center concrete median of 10078 west at mile marker 9.8. Unit #1 was then moved to the right shoulder of 10078 west at mile marker 9.8.
