Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred on Interstate 80 West, Mile Marker 267.5, Foster Township, Luzerne County. Unit #1 was traveling west in the right lane. Unit #1 failed to negotiate a left curve in the roadway. Unit #1 left the north side of the roadway striking a guide rail end with its 12 o'clock position. Unit #1 then traveled across both west bound lanes and became disabled in the left lane around a curve. Unit #2 was traveling west in the left lane. As Unit #2 negotiated the left curve, Unit #2, with its 12 o'clock position struck Unit #1 at its 6 o'clock position. Post Impact, Unit #2 became disabled in the left lane. Unit #3 was traveling west in the left lane. Unit #3 negotiated the left curve in the roadway and struck Unit #1 at its 6 o'clock position with Unit #3's 12 o'clock position. Post impact, Unit #1 struck and went over the guide rail on the south side of the roadway. Operator #1 was extricated from his vehicle and transported vis Medivac to Lehigh Valley Cedar Crest with suspected serious injuries. Operator #2 and Passenger #2 were properly restrained and denied injury. Operator #3 was properly restrained and was transported from the scene for treatment of suspected minor injuries. Unit #1 and Unit #3 were towed from the scene by Kisenwethers Towing. Unit #2 was towed from the scene by Ayers Towing.
