Crash Synopsis:

On 04/03/2024 at approximately 1943 hours, members at PSP Lamar responded to a two vehicle crash with ejection at the above location. This collision occurred as Unit 1, a Mazda CX-5, and Unit 2, a Freightliner truck with an enclosed box semi-trailer, were traveling West in the left passing lane of Interstate 80 W. Unit 2 was approaching heavy traffic congestion up ahead in which the vehicles in both Westbound lanes were traveling considerably slower than the posted speed limit. Unit 2, which already had its headlights and taillights illuminated, engaged it's 4-way hazard lights, and slowed to a speed of approximately 25mph as it entered the traffic congestion. Unit 1, traveling at an unknown speed, struck Unit 2 in a rear-end collision within the westbound passing lane. The two occupants in Unit 2 were uninjured. The operator of Unit 1 sustained serious injuries. Interstate 80 W was shutdown and detoured at the 178 exit. Normal traffic was resumed at 2127 hours. Assisting on scene was Nittany Valley Fire Company, Goodwill Hose Ambulance Company, Tressler's Towing, and PennDOT.

On 04/08/2024, the Lycoming County Coroner Office advised that Operator 1 is deceased as a result from his injuries sustained in this crash.
