Crash Synopsis:

This one vehicle crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling West on I-80 W near mile marker 185.4. Unit 1 reportedly struck a small unidentified object in the roadway, causing Operator 1 to lose control and spin out. Unit 1 subsequently struck the guide rail on the left side. Unit 1 was disabled and towed from scene by Tressler's Towing. The two occupants of Unit 1 were both uninjured.
