INCIDENT DETAILS:

On the above listed date, time, and location PSP Lamar responded for a domestic in progress. Upon arrival, it was learned the Victim allowed the Arrestee to stay the night after a short stay at UPMC Lock Haven for a mental health evaluation. On 04/18/24 at approx. 1151 hrs., a verbal altercation ensued between the Victim and the Arrestee. The Arrestee told the victim he didn't think she was real, and he was going to kill her and burn the house down. While further interviewing the Victim, she realized her vehicle was stolen and the Arrestee was no longer at the residence. The Victim advised the Arrestee does not live with her, has never driven her vehicle, and did not have permission to use the vehicle. While Troopers were on scene, the Arrestee was observed driving the vehicle back to the scene. The Arrestee stopped out front of the residence on the street. The Arrestee was asked multiple times to exit the vehicle. The Arrestee stated, "fuck you," before continued to drive up E. Cardinal drive. A perimeter was set up and the Arrestee was stopped shortly after on W. Cardinal Dr. at its intersection with Oriole Cir. The Arrestee was taken into custody without further incident and the vehicle was returned to the Victim. The Arrestee was transported to Clinton County Prison and was charged with Theft by unlawful taking - movable property, unauthorized use of motor vehicles, resisting arrest, disorderly conduct, and harassment.

Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred on SR-120 westbound in East Keating Twp., Clinton County PA. Unit 1 failed to safely negotiate a right curve in the roadway. Unit 1 traveled off the right side of the road and struck an embankment. Following initial impact, unit 1 rotated clockwise and came to final rest on the double yellow center lines facing south.

Operator 1 fled the crash scene. Operator 1 did not report any injuries.
