INCIDENT DETAILS The Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) at Lykens, Criminal Investigation Unit, investigated the following incident: The above listed Accused made threatening statements of harming the Victim and her family. Through investigaiton, it was determined that the Accused had presviously made statements of conducting a mass shooting and had unlawfully obtained firearms by falsifying statements provided during the background check process. A search warrant was executed on the Accused's residence and numerous firearms, firearms assessories, ammunition, Act 64 items and other items were seized. An arrest warrant was prepared and executed on 08/12/22. The Accused was taken into custody and was transported to the Dauphin County Judicial Center for arraignment on the following criminal charges: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Firearms Act / Materially False Written Statement (F3) - Terroristic Threats (M1) - Unsworn Falsification to Authorities (M3) - Act 64 Possession of Drug Parah (M) - Act 64 Possession of Marijuana (M) - Harrassment (S) A preliminary hearing in this case will be scheduled for MDJ 12-3-01. INCIDENT DETAILS:

On 08/11/22 at 1300 hours, Troopers responded to the Millersburg Borough Building, 101 West Street, Millersburg Borough, Dauphin County for a report of an inactive domestic.

The victim stated that the night prior at approximately 2030 hours, Brandon Nathaniel STROHM, W/N-M Age 23 became enraged and grabbed her by the throat and neck. STROHM then struck her multiple times with a fist in the rib cage, shoulder and head. The victim displayed physical injuries to include bruising and scratches consistent with an assault.

STROHM was taken into custody and transported to the Dauphin County Judicial Center for arraignment on criminal charges of aggravated assault, strangulation, simple assault and harassment. Bail was set at \$25,000 and he was remanded to Dauphin County Prison.

8. INCIDENT DETAILS <p>The Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) will conduct an Impaired Driving Checkpoint in Northern Dauphin County during the month of September. A sobriety checkpoint is a highly visible, systematic method for stopping vehicles at a selected location to determine whether motorists are operating a vehicle under the influence of alcohol or controlled substances.</p> <p>The sobriety checkpoint is funded by a Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PENNDOT) grant and is one of many tools utilized to increase public safety through increased awareness created by high profile enforcement.</p> <p>PSP and PENNDOT are reminding citizens that driving under the influence can not only cost lives, but those who are apprehended face extensive fines. The costs can vary greatly depending on several factors, including blood alcohol content levels (BAC) or Controlled Substances concentrations, location of arrest and number of related offenses associated with the arrest.</p> <p>In conjunction with the sobriety checkpoint, roving DUI enforcement details will occur throughout the month of September 2022.</p>
