Crash Synopsis:

CAD# 4668

This crash occurred as UNIT 1 was traveling east in the left lane of the PA Turnpike, in Lower Allen Township, Cumberland County. As UNIT 1 negotiated a right curve in the roadway, it began to hydroplane and spin to the right, causing UNIT 1 to strike the concrete jersey barrier on the left side of the roadway, with its 8 o'clock causing minor damage. UNIT 1 continued to spin right and struck the concrete jersey barrier with its 11 o'clock causing minor damage. UNIT 1 came to final rest in the right shoulder of the eastbound lanes facing west. OPERATOR 1 was not injured. UNIT 1 was driven from the scene.

There was no turnpike damage in this crash. No injuries were reported.
