Crash Synopsis:

This single vehicle crash occurred on the 1000 Blk of E Main St, Union Twp, Berks County. As unit 1 was traveling west on E main St, they failed to maintain their lane of travel striking a utility pole on the right side of E Main St at the 1 o'clock position. After collision with the utility pole, operator 1 lost control of their vehicle and struck a mailbox at 1239 E Main St. Unit 1 subsequently came to an uncontrolled final rest in the middle of E Main St with the nose end facing northeast. Unit 1 suffered disabling damage to the front of the vehicle, front airbag deployment with the likelihood of internal damage. Operator 1 was transported to Reading Hospital by Tower Health EMS to be medically evaluated. Unit 1 was towed from the scene by Douglassville Autobody. Operator 1 was found to be under the influence of a controlled substance. Charges filed through MDJ 23-3-01.
