This crash occurred at the intersection of Seisholtzville Road/Stein Road, Hereford Township, Berks County. Unit 2 was traveling north on Seisholtzville Road when Unit 1 was attempting to enter the roadway from Stein Road. Operator 1 related that she failed to clear the intersection and subsequently struck Unit 2 at the 3 o'clock position (point of impact). No injuries are reported as a result of this crash. Unit 1 sustained minor damage to its front end at the 11 o'clock position. Unit 2 sustained minor damage to its right passenger quarter panel and also a flat tire. Operator 1 was issued a written warning as a result of this crash for violating Title 75, 3324 - VEHICLE ENTERING OR CROSSING ROADWAY - FAILED TO YIELD RIGHT-OF-WAY WHEN ENTERING OR CROSSING A ROADWAY.
