This crash occurred on State Route 104, Washington Twp., Snyder County as Unit 1 was traveling south. Unit 1 was traveling south and failed to negotiate a right-hand turn. Unit 1 exited the roadway to the west, and struck an embankment. After initial impact occurred Unit 1 struck a utility pole, and came to final rest in a grassy area off the west side of the roadway facing north. Operator 1 was ejected from the vehicle as Unit 1 struck the embankment. Operator 1 came to final rest in the south Bound lane of State Route 104. Operator 1 was pronounced deceased at the scene by Snyder County Coroner, Bill PHEASANT.
