On the above date, time, and location, PSP Skippack conducted a traffic stop on a motor vehicle that violated Pennsylvania vehicle code regulations. While at the scene, the operator displayed multiple signs of alcohol impairment, and he was deemed incapable of operating a motor vehicle safely. Subsequently, the operator was arrested for DUI without incident and transported from the traffic stop location to the PSP Skippack barracks, where he refused a chemical blood test and was subsequently processed for his charges before being released to an Uber driver in accordance with rule 519. This case will remain open until further court proceedings are held for the operator.
