

INCIDENT DETAILS:

On 4/18/21, at approximately 1135 hours, Pennsylvania State Police Stroudsburg Patrol Unit members responded to the area of 343 Sarah Way, Smithfield Township, Monroe County for a report of a parachuter into the woods. Trooper Jasmine BERROCAL and Erin KINGSLEY- Criminal Investigation Unit responded to the scene. Trooper Grayson PEACOCK located the VICTIM, Edward Francis HARNEY (W/N-M 74 YOA) deceased, approximately 363 ft East of Airport Rd, Smithfield Township, Monroe County. In speaking to friends of the VICTIM, it was learned that HARNEY was an experienced sky diver who had just received his jumping gear from being serviced prior to his jump. HARNEY had jumped multiple times at Sky's the Limit Inc. and was accompanied by three other experienced jumpers. HARNEY and three other jumpers along with a pilot traveled to an altitude of approximately 14,000 ft before all four persons jumped together from the plane. At approximately 5,000 ft, all parties broke apart from one another and it appeared as if HARNEYS' first parachute opened. HARNEY began to spiral and spin until his parachute was separated from him. HARNEY then disappeared into the wood line. Deputy Coroner Maurice MORENO of the Monroe County Coroner's Office pronounced HARNEY dead at 1313 hours. HARNEY was removed from the scene by the Monroe County Coroner's Office. An autopsy will be scheduled. The Federal Aviation Administration was notified and will be collecting all parachute apparatus. The scene was processed by FSU. Trooper Jasmine BERROCAL is investigating.

Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred on Main Street (PA611) at its intersection with Mountain Run Farm Road in the Delaware Water Gap Borough, Monroe County.
