Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as Unit#1 was traveling North in the right, Northbound lane of travel on Interstate 380. Unit#1 crossed over the right fog line prior to abruptly turning left, crossing both the right and left Northbound lanes, hitting the guiderail of the left, Northbound shoulder at Unit#1's 11 O'Clock position. This was the initial point of impact and most harmful event for Unit#1. Unit#1 continued traveling back across left and right Northbound lanes prior to coming to final rest on the right, Northbound shoulder of Interstate 380, Tobyhanna Township, Monroe County. Unit#1 was towed from the scene by Murray's Towing Company.

A news release was prepared and submitted.

An SP7-005 (Notice of Crash Investigation) was mailed to Operator#1.
