Crash Synopsis:

This one vehicle crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling westbound on I376 at approx. mile marker 42.5. A deer entered onto the roadway into Unit 1's path to which Unit 1 subsequently impacted the deer at it's 12 o'clock position (front-end). Unit 1 came to a final rest position on the south berm of the roadway facing westbound. The vehicle sustained a disabling amount of damage and was towed from the scene by Munroe Auto Body. Operator 1 was uninjured as a result of the crash and utilized his seat belt.

Crash Synopsis:

This one vehicle crash occurred as Unit#1 was traveling north on I-376 West in Brighton Twp., Beaver Co., when Operator#1 left the roadway to the left and struck the guide wires. Unit#1 then traveled back across the roadway and struck the guide rail on the right side of the roadway where it then spun around and came to rest facing west in the left lane. Operator#1 then moved the vehicle and parked it partially on the shoulder and left lane of I-376 West. Operator#1 was determined to be driving under the influence of narcotics and will be charged via summons.
