Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling West on US HWY 322 Delaware Twp. Juniata County, PA. As Unit 1 was traveling pulling a camper trailer, Operator 1 lost control traveling off the Southern side of the roadway and overturning causing the roadway to be shut down for approximately 3 hours. Operator 1 and Passenger 1 both sustained suspected minor injuries in the crash and were transported to Holy Spirit Hospital. Geedy's Towing removed both units from the scene. Assisting on scene were Mifflintown Fire Company, Port Royal EMS and CJEMS.
