**UPDATE: LEHIGH COUNTY: Attempted Homicide.** *Update to the PaCIC Daily Report dated 09/29/2020. The suspect vehicle has been identified as a silver 2016 Chevrolet Malibu bearing Pennsylvania registration LCH1192, registered to Cierra White, DOB: 12/18/1989. The possible suspect has been identified as Jhan-Mychal Volney, DOB: 06/25/1990. Both individuals are believed to reside on West Lexington Street in Allentown. While Volney should be considered **armed and dangerous**, no arrest warrants have been issued at this time.* On 09/26/2020 at

**MONTGOMERY COUNTY: Access Device Fraud.** On 07/16/2020, a resident of Lower Moreland Township reported the



theft of \$423 from her EPPICard account (a prepaid debit card electronically loaded with child support payments). The victim was the only individual with access to the account and the only card associated was still in her possession. The unauthorized withdrawal was made on Walnut Street in Philadelphia by the pictured male suspect, who also appeared to make at least one other withdrawal using a similar access device. 
