**Crash Synopsis:**

This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling west on US 22 and Unit 2 was traveling east on US 22, Reed Township, Dauphin County. This crash occurred as Unit 1 traveled across the turn lane and into the oncoming east bound lane. Unit 1 hit Unit 2 at approximately Unit 2's 11 o'clock position and Unit 1' 12 o'clock position. Unit 2 left the roadway and came to its final rest off the right shoulder of the east bound lane, facing

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east. Unit 1 came to its final rest facing west in the east bound lane. Operator 1 was trapped in the vehicle and had to be removed by Duncannon Fire. Operator 1 was transported to Holy Spirit by Duncannon EMS with a broken femur and a punctured lung. Operator 2 was evaluated by Newport EMS and was transported to Holy Spirit for a medical evaluation. Both vehicles sustained disabling damaged and were towed from scene. DEP was notified due to Unit 2 leaking fuel in the grass area off of the right shoulder of the eastbound lane.
